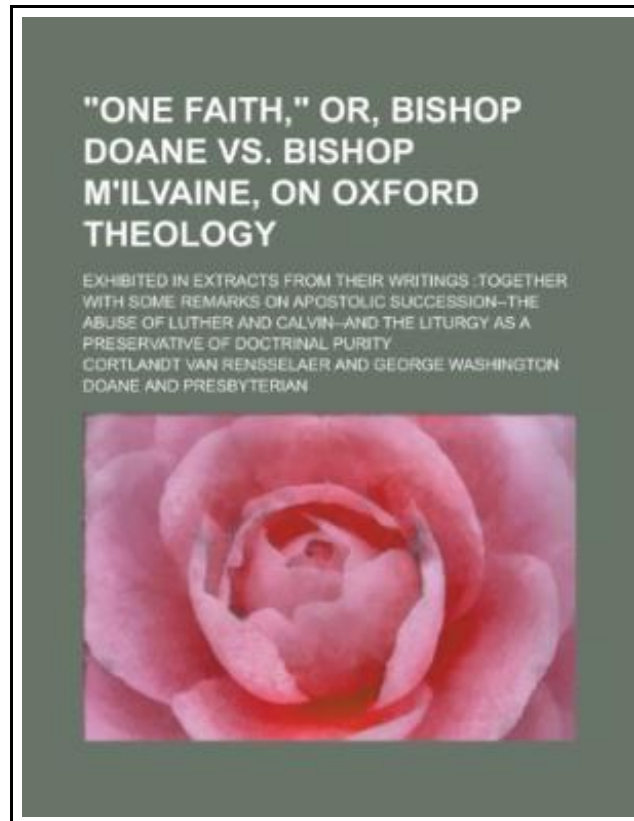

(See Strypes Jlnnals, chap. 12.) Since that period, various High-Church divines have longed for the Altar again, as we may infer from their phraseology. The Prayer-Book, however, puts its veto upon this restoration. Yet they still adhere to the old Popish language; and persist in the name of Altar. This unauthorized innovation upon the language of the Church Service, is especially prevalent during theso days of Popish Tractarianism. Inasmuch as the Prayer-Book never uses th term Altar, in the Communion 8ervice, but always the term Table, why do the lovers of the Prayer-Book. never use Table, but always Altar f And why do they now begin to use the prothesis or little Altar--a phraseology dishonorable both...
